#### BARBARA K. OLSON WOMAN OF VALOR

**Janice Dean** 

Janice Dean currently serves as senior meteorologist for FOX News Channel (FNC) and morning meteorologist for FNC's FOX & Friends (weekdays 6-9AM/ET). Since joining the network in January 2004, Janice has covered a slew of devastating storms including Hurricanes Harvey, Irma, Sandy, Irene, Igor, Earl and Katrina.

Janice stepped up early during the course of the pandemic to demand transparency about what was happening at New York nursing homes and senior residential facilities. Because of her activism, New York citizens learned of the policy mistakes that led to the death of tens of thousands and how government officials sought to obscure this information from the public.

In addition to her role at FOX News Channel, Janice is the author of "Freddy the Frogcaster," a series of children's books tailored towards teaching the weather and she has contributed the earnings from her book to Team Rubicon, an organization that provides relief to those affected by natural disasters.

Prior to joining the network, Janice served as the news editor and entertainment reporter for "Imus in the Morning," and numerous other radio programs. Janice received an honors diploma from Algonquin College in Radio & Television Broadcasting. Janice is a member of the American Meteorological Society and was awarded the AMS Seal of Approval in 2009. She lives in New York with her husband and two sons.

### Honoree



RESILIENCE AWARD
Asra Nomani

Asra Nomani is the Vice President for Strategy and Investigations at Parents Defending Education, where she is the editor of the IndoctriNation database and FOIA work. She is also cofounder of Coalition for TJ, a group of parents and community members in Virginia, a former reporter for *The Wall Street Journal*, codirector of the Pearl Project, and cofounder of the Muslim Reform Movement.

Asra was born in 1965 in Bombay, India, to a Muslim family. She moved to the United States at the age of 4, earned a bachelor's in liberal studies from West Virginia University and then a master's in international communications from American University.

After college, Asra traveled from city to city as a reporter for *The Wall Street Journal*. In addition to her work with *The Wall Street Journal*, she wrote pieces for *The Washington Post*, *The New York Times* and *Time Magazine*, and became a correspondent for Salon.com while embedded in Karachi, Pakistan, during 9/11.

Asra has been an outspoken advocate of women's rights within the Muslim faith, and was a lead organizer of a woman-led Muslim prayer in New York City in March 2005, which was described as "the first mixed-gender prayer on record led by a Muslim woman in 1,400 years."

Asra is a fearless advocate for civility, tolerance, and opportunity, whether it's against intolerant religious leaders, murderous jihadists, or Virginia's corrupt school boards and education systems.

### Honoree



### GENTLEMAN OF DISTINCTION Senator Tim Scott

Growing up in a poor, single parent household, a young Tim Scott grew accustomed to frequent moves and his mom working long hours. After failing four classes his freshman year of high school, Tim's path forward was murky at best.

But thankfully, he had a mom who stuck with him, and met a mentor that showed him the wisdom of

conservative principles. Tim got his grades back on track, graduated from Charleston Southern University, and eventually built his own successful small business. Through the lessons taught by his mentor, Tim developed his mission statement: to positively affect the lives of a billion people. That led him to public service, where he was elected to the Charleston County Council, the South Carolina House of Representatives, the United States House of Representatives, and the United States Senate.

Since joining the Senate in 2013, Tim has been a national leader in bringing opportunity to every American family. His signature legislation creating Opportunity Zones passed in 2017, and has the potential to bring billions of dollars of private investment into distressed communities across the country.

Tim also plays a critical role in issues regarding workforce development, education and diversity. Whether it's tackling the skills gap, making sure children have access to the educational environment best suited for them, or bringing everyone to the table to find solutions, Tim keeps fighting for South Carolinians in the U.S. Senate.

Heather R. Higgins

Heather Higgins is the CEO of Independent Women's Voice and the Chairman of Independent Women's Forum. She has a background in finance, public policy, and media, all happily combined with an inclination to make trouble.

Heather has been recognized as one of Campaigns & Elections 50 Most Influential People for her issue advocacy and a leader who will shape future election cycles.

In addition to receiving numerous awards for her innovative approaches to campaign messaging, in 2016 Heather also received the American Spectator's first "Lifetime Service to the Movement" Award. She writes, most frequently for *The Wall Street Journal*, where she used to be an editorial writer and does television and radio to discuss public policy and politics.

She is a graduate of Princeton University and Harvard's Kennedy School of Government. She lives with her husband and five children in Virginia.

Prior to her current positions, Lisa was part of the executive team of WPA Research where she led the polling efforts for political campaigns across the country. Additionally, Lisa has led communications efforts for congressmen, senators and Super PACs.
